APA Changes 6th Edition // Purdue Writing Lab

Type your title in upper and lowercase letters centered in the upper half of the page. APA recommends that your title be no more than 12 words in length and that it should not contain abbreviations or words that serve no purpose. Your title may take up one or two lines. All text on the title page, and throughout your paper, should be double-spaced.

General Format // Purdue Writing Lab

In Options click Different First Page. On the first (title) page of your paper at the left margin type: Running head: ABBREVIATED TITLE IN UPPER CASE; Tab once or twice to right margin. Click Page number then click Current position then click Plain number. Close the Header & Footer. Scroll to page 2. Click once or twice on [Type here]. Type ABBREVIATED TITLE (omit the label Running head)

APA Style (6th Ed.): Title Page & Running Head - NEW ...

The title page includes the following elements: The Title of the paper should summarize the main idea of the paper, identifying the research question or topic. It should be centred horizontally on the page. The Running head includes an abbreviated form of the title of the paper (flush left) and the page number (flush right).

An APA title page must include: A running head (including page number) The title of your paper (one or two lines long) The full name of the author (s) Your university or institution. Additional information, such as a course number or an author ' s note, should be placed on a separate line below the institution.

Professional papers include a running head on every page, including the title page. However, the " Running head: " label used in the sixth edition is no longer used. The running head is written in all capital letters. The running head should either be identical to the paper ' s title, or a shortened form of the title that conveys the same idea.
